

Arizona Lottery – Loyalty Drawings General Rules

(effective 03/04/24)

This Promotion and/or any parts thereof, including the award of any prizes, is void where prohibited by laws outside the State of Arizona. Promotions are not sponsored or endorsed by, or affiliated in any way with Apple, or any other 3rd party application provider or affiliate.

Game Period

The Arizona Lottery (the "Lottery") is conducting online Loyalty Drawings (the "Drawings"). The Loyalty Drawing period for any specific Drawing can be found on that Drawing's entry submission page.

1. A player may enter a Drawing by: 1) going to arizonalottery.com and clicking on the Players Club link; 2) going directly to the Players Club website at azplayersclub.com (the "Website"); or 3) using the Arizona Lottery Players Club mobile app (the "Mobile App").
2. A player must complete the required registration information and confirm that the player is: 1) is twenty-one (21) years of age or older; 2) has voluntarily waived confidentiality rights under A.R.S. § 5-573(D); and 3) has read the Official Rules of a Drawing.
3. To enter a Drawing, a player must redeem the number of points earned through Players Club activities ("Points") required for that specific Drawing during the Drawing period. The number of Points required for entry into any given Drawing may vary. The number of Points needed for any specific Drawing can be found on that Drawing's entry submission page. See the official Players Club Terms and Conditions for information on how to collect and redeem Points.
4. The total number of Points a player can use for entry into a Drawing is limited to the number of Points he/she has available in his/her Account and any caps on the specific Drawing. It is the player's responsibility to ensure that the appropriate Drawing and quantity are selected. All Point redemptions for Drawings are final and the Points will be deducted immediately from the player's Account.
5. The number of required Points for redemption are subject to change. Any changes will be posted on the Website and Mobile App as they become available. Draw dates and Drawing Point values are subject to change.
6. Drawing entries are eligible only for the Drawing for which they were used. Unless specified otherwise on the Drawing description, entries are eligible for one (1) Drawing only.
7. The player will receive confirmation they have completed their Points transaction, the associated Points will be deducted from their Account and the transaction will be displayed in their Players Club History tab.
8. The odds of a player being selected to win a prize in any Drawing depends upon the number of entries (received through Points) from all players.
9. During the Drawing period, the Lottery may add special features to the Drawing allowing a player to receive additional entries for Points entered into the Drawing. Such special features may include, but are not limited to, double entries on a specific day, or any other special requirements designed to increase participation in the Players Club. Any special features will be noted on the Website.
10. An entry received during a specified entry period is only eligible for the corresponding Drawing. Entries for a Drawing not received by the specified entry deadline date will not be rolled over into another Drawing. Entries cannot be submitted after the entry deadline for the Drawing.
11. Drawing entries are eligible for one drawing only. A player may win no more than one prize in any drawing. Points used for drawing entries may not be cancelled or returned.
12. Entries may only be submitted using the Website or Mobile App.
13. If a dispute arises over the eligible entrant, the named player of the email account associated with the entry registration will be the official entrant.

Drawings

1. For prizes valued greater than \$599, one (1) Prizewinner and three (3) alternates will be selected for each prize awarded in a Drawing. If a selected winning entry is determined to be invalid, and thus disqualified, the next available alternate will become eligible to assume the prize. In the event the Prizewinner and initial alternates are disqualified, additional alternates will be selected from the same pool of entrants used for the Drawing.
2. For prizes valued greater than \$599, the Prizewinner's name and town of residence will be posted on the Website and Mobile App following the validation of the Prizewinner. Prizewinners shall be notified via email and/or phone by the Lottery or its designee within seven (7) calendar days after the Drawing. The prizewinner list is subject to change based on verification of the Prizewinners by the Lottery.
3. Alternates will not be drawn for cash prizes valued at \$599 and below. If the Lottery or its designee is unable to contact the Prizewinner or the Prizewinner does not timely respond within seven (7) calendar days of Lottery contact, the Prizewinner forfeits any prize and the prize will become part of the unclaimed prize fund allocated for future Promotions and Promotion Drawings.
4. Prizewinners shall be randomly selected from all valid Website and Mobile App entries received for each Drawing.
5. The Drawings will be conducted by Pollard Banknote Limited at their offices at 1499 Buffalo Place, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada. The drawing location may change at the discretion of the Lottery.
6. Drawing dates and the number of Drawings are subject to change at the discretion of the Arizona Lottery.

Exclusive Segmentation Drawings

1. Exclusive Player Loyalty Drawings may be offered to a segment of qualified players selected by the Arizona Lottery in an effort to gauge player interest, improve player experience and/or increase player engagement for all registered players. The segment of players will be selected by the lottery at its discretion based on player inactivity or selective activity. An example of a segment would be players who have historically played only one game type.
2. Exclusive Player Loyalty Drawings may require that the player perform an activity to gain an entry into the drawing. An example of an activity would be that the player completes a survey created to learn more about the player's preferences or experience within the Players Club platform.

Prizes

1. A player is eligible to win only one (1) prize per drawing.
2. Prizes are not transferable.
3. The odds of winning vary, based on the total number of entries received for a Drawing and the total number of entries (received through Points) a player submits.
4. Players are responsible for ensuring that their email address is secure to accept payment. The Arizona Lottery is not responsible for compromised or insecure email accounts and no refund will be issued in the event that winning payment to their account is compromised.

Entry Eligibility Requirements

1. All Drawing entries are subject to validation by the Lottery or its designee and may be disqualified if eligibility requirements are not met.
2. If a player who both 1) resides outside of the State of Arizona and 2) does not have an Arizona address is selected as a winner in a promotion in which the prize includes Scratchers tickets, the player will be responsible for picking up their prize at an official Arizona Lottery office location, as determined by the Arizona Lottery.
3. A player must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older to enter the Drawing.

4. Players, transactions, and Prizewinners are subject to all Lottery Official Rules, state laws, orders of the Lottery Commission, the Terms of Use and the Privacy Policy on the Website, the Lottery drawing procedures, and any applicable laws outside the State of Arizona affecting the Drawing.

Disqualification

1. The Website and Mobile App are the only methods of entry into a Drawing.
2. A.R.S. § 5-573 requires winners of a prize valued at \$600 or more to be checked to determine if that Prizewinner owes money to certain State of Arizona entities. In the event that a component of the prize or the entire prize is non-cash (experiential) and the selected winner owes money to a State of Arizona entity, the selected Prizewinner will be disqualified and the next available alternate will become eligible to assume the prize.
3. “Ineligible Player” is a person who is directly employed by the Arizona Lottery or a Familial Person (e.g., spouse, children, parents, siblings, housemates, roommates, friends and/or romantic partners) whose principal residence is the same as such Arizona Lottery employee. Such person is prohibited from participation in Arizona Lottery games. Additionally, any vendor or contractor who is responsible for supplying gaming equipment or Arizona Lottery tickets, advertising, consulting services, who participates in any way with the drawings or otherwise selecting winning Arizona Lottery tickets or who has access to secured Arizona Lottery locations or a Familial Person (e.g., spouse, children, parents, siblings, housemates, roommates, friends and/or romantic partners) whose principal residence is the same as such vendor or contractor or the immediate supervisor of such vendor or contractor is an Ineligible Player and is prohibited from participation in Arizona Lottery games.
4. The Lottery and/or its administrators, at their sole discretion, may disqualify a player, Prizewinner, or designee from participating in any aspect of the Drawing if they deem or suspect that such person has engaged in or has attempted to engage in any of the following: (a) acting in violation of the law, these Official Rules, or the Terms of Use or Privacy Policy; (b) damaging, tampering with or corrupting the operation of the Website or Mobile App; (c) acting with intent to annoy, harass, or abuse any other person; (d) using any automated bot, macro, script, or other robotic, mechanical, programmed or automated devices to submit data or spam to the Website or Mobile App; (e) making repeated attempts to submit invalid multiple entries; (f) participating in any unsportsmanlike, inappropriate, uncooperative, disruptive, fraudulent, or potentially fraudulent behavior or activity; or (g) participating in any activity deemed to be generally inconsistent with the intended operation of the Drawing. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY A PERSON TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE OR CORRUPT ANY OF THE LOTTERY'S WEBSITES OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE DRAWING IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE LOTTERY AND ITS ADMINISTRATORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO PROSECUTE AND SEEK DAMAGES FROM ANY SUCH INDIVIDUAL TO THE FULLEST EXTENT OF THE LAW.

Use of Personal Information

1. The collection, use, storage, and destruction of personal information submitted by a player for participation in the Drawings will be managed in accordance with the Privacy Policy and the Terms of Use of the Website.
2. A player is required to be twenty-one (21) years of age or older to provide information that will be collected on the Website.
3. By submitting a Drawing entry on the Website or via the Mobile App, a player gives the Lottery permission to announce and publish the player's name, city and state for marketing/promotional purposes if the player wins a prize. Because a Drawing is exclusively used as a promotional event, a person who participates in a Drawing is deemed to have voluntarily waived the right under A.R.S. § 5-573(D) to keep his or her name confidential for ninety (90) days after winning a prize. A player who does not want to consent to immediate release of his or her name as a winner should not participate in this Drawing, will be ineligible to receive a prize in a Drawing, and will be disqualified if chosen as a Prizewinner, resulting in selection of an alternate Prizewinner.

Claiming Requirements

1. Prizewinners must provide their legal name and address. For prizes of \$600 or more, Prizewinners must complete a Winner Claim Form, provide their taxpayer ID (typically their social security number), provide a form of government-issued photo identification, and pass all validation checks prior to claiming their prize. The Lottery will report such wins to the applicable tax authorities. Each Prizewinner is responsible for his or her state, federal, and/or local taxes.
2. Prizewinners must claim their prize within seven (7) calendar days from the prizewinner notification date by the Lottery. If all reasonable efforts to locate a Prizewinner fail within the seven (7) calendar-day period, the Lottery may select a replacement winner as previously described. Deadlines for claiming prizes will be clearly noted in all communication to the Prizewinner(s). If the prize awarded is an event in which a seven (7) calendar claiming period is not possible and a shorter claiming period is required, the adjusted claiming period will be noted in all communication to the Prizewinner(s)
3. Disqualification, forfeiture, and the selection of an alternate potential Prizewinners may result from any of the following: (a) the potential Prizewinner's failure to respond to any notification within the specified response period; (b) the return of an email notification as undeliverable after three (3) attempts; (c) the return of any other notice as undeliverable; (d) the potential Prizewinner's failure to provide satisfactory proof of age, identity, and residency; (e) the potential Prizewinner's failure to execute and return the required documents (including, without limitation, the Winner Claim Form) within the specified return period; (f) the potential Prizewinner's failure to be available to receive the prize; (g) the potential Prizewinner's failure to validly claim the prize by the date specified in the prize award notification; or (h) any other non-compliance with the law, these Official Rules, the Terms of Use, or the Privacy Policy. In the event of a forfeiture of the prize, the Lottery may, in its sole discretion, award or not award the forfeited prize to an alternate winner.

Miscellaneous

1. Approximately one hundred eighty (180) days after the completion of a Drawing, all non-winning, non-selected and/or ineligible entries shall be deleted.
2. The Lottery reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify these Official Rules without materially affecting the terms and conditions of a Drawing. The Lottery reserves the right to modify, cancel, postpone, delay, suspend, and/or terminate a Drawing, in whole or in part, in the event that the Drawing is not capable of running as planned or as intended by these Official Rules, by reason of any technical or other disabling causes, or other causes that impair, corrupt, or interrupt the administration, fairness, security, integrity, or proper play of a Drawing, including, without limitation, hurricane, fire, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, war, terrorist threat, or activity or insurrection. In such event, the Lottery may, in its sole discretion: (a) postpone and/or reschedule and/or modify a Drawing, or (b) cancel a Drawing in its entirety. In the event of cancellation, the Lottery shall award the prizes through a process deemed fair and equitable by the Lottery, in its sole discretion, and the Lottery and its administrators shall have no further liability to any participant in connection with a Drawing. In no event will the Lottery be obligated to award more prizes than the number of prizes stated in these Official Rules.
3. Whether caused by a player, equipment, or programming associated with or utilized in a Drawing, or by any technical or human error that may occur in the processing of entries, the Lottery, Pollard Banknote Limited are not responsible for inaccurate entry information or errors that may occur in the processing of a Drawing that may be the result of: (a) error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries; or (b) lost, misdirected, late, incomplete, corrupted, illegible, or unintelligible entries. Corrupted, illegible, unintelligible, or incomplete entries are void.
4. The Lottery reserves the right to substitute prizes with similar merchandise of equal or greater value. No prize substitution, cash equivalent, or transfer of prize by a winner in violation of these Official Rules is permitted. By accepting a prize, a player agrees to release the Lottery and Pollard Banknote Limited from, and shall hold them harmless against, any liability, loss, claims, injury, or damage to property or to person, including death, due in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, by reason of the acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prizes or participation in a Drawing, even if caused or contributed to by the negligence of the Lottery and Pollard Banknote Limited.

5. A Drawing is governed by laws and regulations of the State of Arizona, and all players hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the State of Arizona for resolution of all claims and disputes through administrative hearing, and any right to a trial by jury is hereby waived. Any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or connected with a Drawing or any prize awarded are governed by Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") § R19-3-1008. The decision of the Lottery is final. Any decision by the Lottery Director is a final, appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearings under the procedures of A.A.C. § R2-19-101 through § R2-19-122. Exhaustion of administrative remedies applies.
6. If any provision or provisions of these Official Rules, the Terms of Use, or the Privacy Policy is, or will be, held to be invalid, illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with the law of any jurisdiction, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions will not in any way be affected or impaired thereby. The Lottery's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.
7. Players or interested parties must use the Feedback form for any questions or comments they may have about a Drawing.
8. Arizona Lottery Loyalty Drawings are Arizona Lottery Promotions and are not sponsored or endorsed by, or affiliated in any way with Apple, or any other 3rd party application provider or affiliate.
